


MISSION STATEMENT

Drop off / Sign in Procedure & Pick-Up

School drop-off is from 9:00-9:10am each morning. Parents or caregiver must sign the child in on the sign-in sheet each day which will include emergency contact information and the person picking up the child that day. Children will be released to the person(s) who have been listed in writing on the sign in sheet. If someone different will be picking up your student, please notify Bloom as soon as possible. We may require the person picking up your child to show identification if our staff is unfamiliar with them. All students must be picked up by 12:05pm.

Snacks and Belongings

Please send a nutritious nut free snack each day with your child. On occasions we will be using a food item as a part of our lesson and it may include taste testing! If we will be providing any additional food that day it will be noted on the front door at the time of drop-off. Please notify a staff member before you leave if you do not want your child to have the snack item. Please label all items that you leave with your student with their name.

Birthdays and Holidays

We love to celebrate birthdays and we want it to be special for your child. We do allow parents to bring in special treats for the class! If you plan to bring a special birthday treat, let us know what it is and we will include it on the daily calendar. We will have holiday parties throughout the year. There are no obligations but the teacher will provide a sign-up sheet in advance if you would like to donate items for the parties.





Show and Tell

Each child will have a chance to bring their favorite items to school. The teacher will let you know the day your child can bring those items. Show and Tell is a great way for your child to share things about his/her interest. Every student will have a special week to be a Star Student for show and tell. Your teacher will provide you with this information when it is time for your child to be the Star Student.

Photographs

Throughout our school year, photographs of the children will be taken in our classroom during their activities. These photos may be used for marketing if you have signed our photo release. We will also utilize a photo app so that we can easily share photos with you and you can see how much fun your little one is having while at school!

Newsletters

Your teacher will provide a monthly newsletter to communicate important information, topics, or upcoming events to provide as much information as we can to keep you informed about what goes on in our class! On occasion we may ask you to bring some personal items from home to help with our lessons. We do this to engage the students and families more in the lessons.



Potty Training

Don't worry, we have been there! If your little one is not fully potty trained that does not mean that they cannot participate! Please speak with the teacher ahead of time to let them know how to best help your little one. Please send a change of clothes and have your dancer in a pull-up if not fully potty trained. If they have an accident that allows them to clean up and change their clothes themselves, we will help them as needed. If they have an accident and cannot change themselves we will call you to come and change your child.

Homework


Don't worry parents! We do not assign homework! Once per month we will send home a short parent support guide. This helps you easily incorporate the month's concepts into your home and your preschooler will love it!

Weather Closures

In the event that we need to close for inclement weather we will first notify you via email. We will also post on our facebook page and website. As a general rule we will follow the decisions of Adams 12 and BVSD regarding weather related closures.

Make-Ups

Due to the nature of our program, we are not able to offer make-ups for missed classes or weather closures. We can offer a make-up class for the movement portion of your class in one of our dance classes. Simply notify the office to schedule a make-up class.





Illness

Colds, flu and other contagious diseases are common in preschoolers. We do our best to keep all items in the classroom clean and we encourage hand washing throughout the day, however, there are times a child may get sick. We would need you to keep your child home if he/she shows any of the following:

Nasal discharge yellow/green

Discharge from eyes or ears

Complaints of ear pain

Diarrhea

Infestation (Lice, scabies, pinworm) Rash,
with fever

Severe Sore throat/cough

Conjunctivitis (pink eye)

Temperature 101 degrees


Vomiting

Impetigo

Infectious/Contagious Disease (hand/foot/mouth disease, chicken pox, fifth disease, strep throat, etc). Please contact the Director so that other parents will be informed.

Your child may return to school after he/she has had no temperature for 24hrs without medication.

If your child shows any symptoms from the list above, you will be called to come and pick up your child immediately.





Payments

There is a non-refundable \$50 registration and materials fee due at the time of registration. Payments are due on the 1st of the month and are considered late after the 10th of the month. There is a \$15 late fee added to accounts after the 10th of the month. We highly suggest signing up for our monthly auto-pay plan. Bloom preschool is a season long commitment. Your first payment will be due on August 1st. Classes run from August 17, 2020 to May 21, 2021. Each payment covers 4 weeks (a 9 month school year) therefore, there is no payment due for the month of May!
